




SYNOPSIS

Turo (25) is stuck in a small village in Northern Finland. The only glimpses of light in his life are provided by the amateur metal band, Impaled Rektum, whose vocalist he is. He and his friends have played for 12 years without having a single gig.

The guys get a surprise visitor from Norway: the head of Northern Damnation, a huge metal festival. They decide that it's now or never. After a miserable warm-up gig Impaled Rektum breaks up just to get together again. They steal a van, a corpse and a coffin from the local cemetery, a new drummer from the local mental hospital and flee to Norway. As they are escaping Finnish police, they have to face the Norwegian Army and its notorious "Delta troppen" in order to get to play their first real gig.

Johannes Holopainen (Turo Moilanen)

Johannes Holopainen (born 1988) is a finnish actor, who is most known for his role in film The Unknown Soldier (2017 dir by Aku Louhimies). Holopainen graduated from Uniarts Helsinki's Theatre Academy in 2013 and since then he has been acting in multiple theatre productions for example Pasi Was Here, Kokki, Vaimo ja Rakastaja at Kom-teatteri and in tv-series such as Tellus. During the spring of 2018 Holopainen will also be seen in feature film East of Sweden (dir by Simo Halinen).

Minka Kuustonen (Miia Kujanpää)

Minka Kuustonen (born 1985) is one of the most well known actresses in Finland. She has been in more than 10 tv-series and played multiple main roles in feature films (Wendy and the Refugee Neverland 2017, Gold-digger 2016, Summertime 2014). Minka also has been working in Finnish national theatre and she has MA degree in acting.

Ville Tiihonen (Jouni Tulkku)

Ville Tiihonen (born 1974) is a finnish actor, who has played many versatile roles from comedy to crime. He's been in several tv-series and films (Wendy and the Refugee Neverland 2017, Off The Map 2016, Vares - Tango of Darkness 2012) and he is also a part of improvisation theater group called Stella Polaris.

Kai Nordberg

Kai Nordberg was born 1968 in Helsinki. During 1989 — 1994 he worked as a foreign correspondent and photographer in Berlin. In 1989 he also started film, TV and journalism studies at Freie Universität in Berlin. He developed an ambition for cinema and started to direct and produce his own films. Nordberg is the CEO of the company Making Movies Ltd founded in 1996. Since the start of the company he has produced and directed over 100 films.

Kaarle Aho

Kaarle Aho (b.1968, Helsinki — MA, University of Helsinki) has produced films and TV in Making Movies since 1998. The films produced by Kaarle Aho have won six Jussi-prizes (Finnish Oscars), a Venla-prize (the best TV-drama in Finland) and two Kettu-prizes (the best short film in Finland). He is a co-founder of Making Movies Ltd and in 2008 he was selected as the producer of the year in Finland together with his business partner Kai Nordberg.

Making Movies Oy (Ltd.) is a Finnish film production company based in Helsinki. Established in 1996 the company produces and co-produces fiction and documentary films for international market. The managers, founding members and shareholders of Making Movies are Kai Nordberg and Kaarle Aho.

Since 1996 Making Movies has produced 10 feature films and more than 70 documentary and short films and tv-dramas. The films produced by Making Movies have been distributed in more than 50 countries worldwide.

In spring 2015 Making Movies released Klaus Härö's feature film The Fencer (Finnish Oscar nominee for 2016). The Fencer was nominated for a Golden Globe in a Best Foreign Language Film category and it was Oscar shortlisted.
